THEME: GLOBAL SOLIDARITY SHARED RESPONSIBILTY

Every year, on December 1, the world commemorates World AIDS Day. People around the world unite to show support for people living with and affected by HIV and to remember those who lost their lives to AIDS. In 2020, the world's attention has been focused by the COVID-19 pandemic on health and how pandemics affect lives and livelihoods. COVID-19 is showing once again how health is interlinked with other critical issues, such as reducing inequality, human rights, gender equality, social protection and economic growth. With this in mind, this year the theme of World AIDS Day is "Global solidarity, shared responsibility".

POSTER/PHOTO SUBMISSION: DEADLINE-GUIDELINES-INSTRUCTIONS-RULES-RESOURCES RESTRICTIONS-Due to funding restrictions, this contest is restricted to current students of the following high schools: LAUSD's Carson Complex: Academies of Education and Empowerment (AEE), Academy of Medical Arts (AMA), Carson HS, Eagle Tree HS and CVUHSD Leuzinger HS in Lawndale, CA.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Maximum POSTER SIZE: 8.5" X11"
- POSTER Language: ENGLISH/SPANISH/ANY OTHER LANGUAGES (Spanish and other languages must have translations attached with entry form).

The following items must be reflected in the Poster or Photo

- The AIDS Awareness Ribbon must be visible somewhere on the poster/photo.
- The words WORLD AIDS DAY must be included. ie: Subject line should be formatted to serve as TITLE OF POSTER and read WORLD AIDS DAY
- This year's THEME: GLOBAL SOLIDARITY SHARED RESPONSIBILTY
- AIDS and HIV must be CAPITALIZED.
- No nudity, obscenity, (cursing), bad, hateful, inappropriate language or messages
- Submissions with hiv, aids, Aids, or Hiv WILL BE REJECTED.
- Submit one entry per person per category. Photos and Posters are considered one category.
- Your entry must be attached with an ENTRY SUBMISSION FORM, signed by you the creator. If more than one creator everyone involved must sign and clearly print their names.
- If under 18 years of age please have parent or guardian sign the submission form.

Body of email must contain you name, age, school and teacher's name (if applicable), a brief description (100 words max) describing your message and what inspired you, or what your learned while creating your art work. Following you may find facts about HIV/AIDS, video campaigns and artwork to help you with ideas.
