Our staff will work with you and your financial situation to review all eligible programs. We assist you in finding the best option, completing paperwork and enrollment. There are many programs available.

T h e o p t i o n s :

There are a handful of insurance and assistance options available in California. They are based on several factors of which our staff works with you to decide the best fit for your needs.

Medi-Cal

Medi-Cal is a public assistance program that is free or low-cost which is dependent on an individual's income and household size.

Qualifications: U.S. citizens, legal residents and some immigrants regardless of legal status.

Covered California

Covered California, also known as the Affordable Care Act, is based on annual income, age and where you live.

Qualifications: U.S. citizens and legal residents.

My Health LA

My Health LA is not insurance, but is a program designed for low-income people who don't qualify for Medi-Cal or Covered California. This program covers medical services community clinics provide.

Qualifications: Low/no income individuals needing health care.

Medicare

Medicare parameters can be a bit more complicated and our staff are able to work with you on qualifications. The costs vary based upon the different plan tiers and supplements chosen, age and where you live. Our staff will assist enrolling patients into the best plan that fulfills their needs.

Qualifications: US citizens over 65 who have worked, or has had a spouse that worked for a minimum of 10 years and have paid taxes.

Sliding Fee Discount Program



At South Bay Family Health Care no patient will ever be turned away if they are unable to pay. Our Doctors and staff work to make sure you and your family receive the quality health care you need. Self-paying patients receive a generous discount on their bill(s) through a sliding fee discount program which is based on federal income guidelines.

Qualifications: Anyone can apply for the sliding scale discount, even those who have insurance. The program is designed so that people pay for health care services based upon their ability to pay. In other words, those who make less, will pay less. Approval is based upon annual income and family size.
