can get vaccinated.**

**You don't need a social
security number or
immigration status to get
vaccinated for COVID.**

**You do not need a
government-issued ID
or a letter from
your employer
to get a vaccine.**

accepted IDs.**

**The COVID vaccine
is free.**

**The vaccine is free for everyone,
regardless of immigration status.**

**Getting the vaccine
will not impact your
current or future
immigration status,
and you won't be
asked about your
immigration status.**

**It is NOT considered in a
public charge test.**

**Your information
is safe.**

**Your medical information is
private and will not be shared
with immigration officials.**
